

Maui Prince



The attraction of this site is turtles. You'll easily see up to a dozen or more any time you snorkel or dive here. I actually think this is a better snorkel site than a dive site, but there is lot's to see either way. Drive approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile past the Maui Prince and turn right at the first intersection. There are a couple of parking lots at the end of that road. You'll have to walk a bit to a park on your left. There are picnic areas, a freshwater shower and restrooms. The beach is a nice sandy beach which is also a great place to warm up during your surface interval. Enter the water at the left side of the beach and swim out to the end of the rock outcropping. Again, if there is a south swell, consider another location.

You will occasionally see a turtle stick its head out of the water, but most of the time, they just like to sit on the bottom. They can blend in with the bottom, but you'll quickly learn to spot them. We've had huge snorkel boats come into this location and anchor. It's nice to know that those folks each spent more than \$50 while we just swam a bit.
