

Mile Post 14



Mile post 14 was a snorkel location we enjoyed often. The coral reef is very near the shore and is very colorful. It can form a maze so sometimes you have to work a bit to find your way back to shore.

This site has permanently posted signs indicating that there have been shark attacks at this location. I'm not aware of any recent attacks. This location is used heavily and several snorkel boats anchor just offshore. I don't think it's especially dangerous, but the signs do serve as a reminder that when you enter the ocean you're also entering the food chain. I would never dive here if the water was murky or after any significant rain.

Park as close to the mile post sign as practicable. During extremely high tides and parking can be difficult. There's a channel that is marked by a post just offshore. That is one way to get outside of the reef. On the other hand, it's often fun just to poke around in the shallow reefs.
